

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TRAINERS

## Remington Park Hair Testing

- Hair testing is required prior to entry for all horses.
- Cost of test is \$225.
- The tests are good for 90 days from the date it is pulled. If your test expires, you will be unable to enter.
- For February and March, testing will be done Monday - Friday (please check schedule for exceptions).
- Appointments are required! Call or text (405) 881-5120 by noon the day before.
- The hair testing office is in room 5 of the stakes barn.
- Once an appointment is made, owner can pay online here: <https://form.jotform.com/240146070558150>
- We will need front and back copies of registration papers.
- Allow 10 BUSINESS days for results to be returned. No entries will be accepted before the results are reported.
- OQHRA tries to check all horses eligible for Futurities and Derbies and notify trainer if a horse has not tested, **this a courtesy**, the responsibility to have a horse tested at the proper time belongs to the trainer only.
- All Futurities and Derbies require qualifier testing between the trials and the finals.
- The first day of testing at Remington Park will be Wednesday (2/7) The last safe day to test for opening weekend is Feb. 14th (there will be no testing on 2/13).

### !!NEW THIS YEAR!!

- ✓ If a single trainer has 10 or more horses to be tested on one day and those horses are in the barns at Remington Park (exception C1), we can come to your barn and test AFTER training hours. The trainer must schedule 48 hours in advance. The trainer will need to come to the hair testing office the morning of testing and complete all paperwork and take care of payment. There will be no additions or switches in the barn – NO EXCEPTIONS.
- ✓ For Qualifier testing we will go to the horse.
- ✓ All other testing will be done in the RP Stakes barn 9-11am.
- ✓ The Remington Park executive offices get all positive test results, they will notify the trainer in a timely manner. All positive tests will be posted publicly online at [www.oqhra.com](http://www.oqhra.com).
- ✓ Each trainer must complete the trainer consent form prior to their horses being tested. The form can be completed online here: <https://form.jotform.com/240234986126054>
