Other Conditions: For a horse to be eligible to run in the trials, it must be owned or leased by berth owner at time horse is named. Any prohibited medication positives will result in loss of eligibility to participate in trials or finals as determined by OHRC Stewards. If pre-race examination or drug testing prior to or following race refused by owner or trainer of eligible horse and results in the horse being ineligible to participate, there will be no refund of payments.

Oklahoma Bred Awards Paid to 1st-5th place in the Futurity & Derby:
45%, 25%, 15%, 10%, 5% • Trial Purses \$5,000 est.

If a payment is missed, that payment must be doubled to remain eligible. Added money includes \$10,000 per race from the Oklahoma Breeding Development Fund as well as \$40,000 for the Futurity and \$25,000 for the Derby as well as an additional \$25,000 for the Futurity from the Horsemen's Purse Account. It is the responsibility of the owner and/or trainer to make sure their entry is duly registered and eligible by meeting all conditions as published. Should a horse be ineligible and scratched, all fees paid in will be forfeited to the purse and not subject to refund. By making entry into this race, I agree to abide by the rules and regulations as published by the OQHRA, OHRC, Will. Rogers Downs and enforced by the Board of Stewards and to accept their decision as final.

Race conditions available upon request and will be provided at the time original nomination is received. Please retain a copy for your records. 12% from payments deducted for A&A. All added money, dates and conditions are subject to OHRC approval.

- 3. PAYMENTS:** Except as provided herein, the failure to make all payments on or before the designated dates will result in a termination of the nomination and all prior nominating and sustaining payments will be forfeited. All payments must be postmarked no later than the due date and should be sent by registered or certified mail. The sender's receipt must be date stamped by the United States Postal Service and presented as proof of mailing if date discrepancies occur. Postage metered dates will not be accepted if payments are not received by the due date. United States Postal Service date stamped metered mail will constitute evidence of mailing if dated, mailed, and stamped on or before due date. All returned checks constitute no payment. In the event a sustaining payment is late (the "Late Payment"), a nomination of the eligible horse will not be terminated if, on or before the due date of the next immediate sustaining payment (or the entry date if the late payment is the last sustaining payment), the person nominating the eligible horse pays (a) such next sustaining payment; (b) the late payment; and (c) an additional amount equal to the late payment. The foregoing provision will not apply to consecutive sustaining payments. The Credit card payments will be subject to a 3.5% convenience fee.
- 4. ADDED MONEY AND PURSE DISTRIBUTION:** The Net Purse for the Futurity will include all nomination fees, sustaining fees and late fees less 12% of the foregoing for advertising, accounting, and administrative expenses plus \$75,000 which includes \$40,000 from the TATPF and \$10,000 from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. The Net Purse for the Derby will include all nomination fees, sustaining fees and late fees less 12% of the foregoing for advertising, accounting, and administrative expenses plus \$25,000 which includes \$15,000 from the TATPF and \$10,000 from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. Final purse money distributed by track will pay 10 places using the following formula: 40%, 18%, 12%, 8%, 6%, 5%, 4%, 3%, 2%, 2%. Oklahoma Bred Awards paid to 1st-5th places using the following formula: 45%, 25%, 15%, 10%, 5%.
- 5. SUPPLEMENTARY NOMINATIONS:** There are no supplemental nominations allowed at time of entry.
- 6. TIME TRIALS:** A sufficient number of trial heats will be run, the number of horses in each heat will be adjusted depending upon the final entries. In the time trials, horses shall qualify on the basis of time and order of finish. The times of the horses in time trials will be determined only to the limit of the timer, the only exception is when two or more horses have the same exact time in the same trial heat. Then the order of finish shall also determine the preference in qualifying or the finals. Except in the case of a disqualification, under no circumstances shall a horse qualify ahead of a horse that finished ahead of that horse in the official order of finish. Should a horse be disqualified for interference during the running of a time trial, it shall receive the time of the horse it is immediately placed behind plus one hundredth (1/100) of a second, or to the maximum accuracy of the electronic timing device. No adjustments shall be made in the times recorded in the time trials to account for head wind, tail wind, off track, etc. In the event of a timer malfunction for a trial race, the stewards will use the technological aid of video frame by frame analysis to assign times to each participating horse in that trial.
- 7. TIES:** If a tie exists the horses involved shall draw lots to determine which shall participate in the finals. The decision of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission will be final in all matters.
- 8. SCRATCHES:** If a horse is ruled ineligible by the stewards or the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission for entry into either the trials or the finals or if the stewards scratch or disqualify a horse from either a trial or the finals described herein for a rule violation, such horse may be ineligible for receipt of any purse money. After the entry date for the finals, the purse money that might have been due to such horse will be divided proportionately (based on purse percentages) among the other starters in such race. If, after the entry date for such race, one or more horses are withdrawn from the finals for any reason other than ineligibility or a rule violation, the purse monies (in inverse order of finish) equal to the number of withdrawn horses for such race will be distributed equally to the owners of the horses withdrawn from such final. If the front gates or the starting gate fail to open due to mechanical failure, or if a horse is left behind the gate when the field is dispatched during the running of the trials, such horse may be declared non-starter and the stewards may determine that owner is entitled a refund of all nominating, sustaining and entry fees but not including administrative and advertising fees deducted from gross purse with a subsequent revision in the final purse distribution to reflect the refunded amount. During the running of the finals such horse may be declared a non-starter and shall be classified as a scratched horse and shall be paid last place purse money in the race.
- 9. ENTRY:** Entries in all races must be made through the entry box at Will Rogers Downs by closing time for entries in that race. Each horse must pass entry before running in trials or finals. Prior to racing, an owner is required to have on deposit with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper the amount required to cover all costs of starting a horse, including minimum jock mount for trial races if required by the racetrack conducting the races.

10. **FINALS:** Finalists will be determined by taking the ten (10) fastest times from all the trials. Every qualifier eligible to enter the finals will be required to remain on the grounds and stabled in the barn area of the racetrack after the trials and until the running of the finals. The finals will consist of a field of no more than ten (10) horses unless otherwise determined within these conditions. In addition to the pre-entry hair testing, **only the fastest 15 qualifiers for the 2023 Futurity and 15 qualifiers for the Derby based on trial times will be eligible and required to comply with collection of another hair sample which will be collected and tested after the trials and prior to entry for the finals at a time and location set by the race administrator. Any horse failing to produce a clean hair test free of prohibited substances will not be eligible to enter the finals regardless of the qualifying time.** In the event ten (10) or fewer horses enter the trials, only those who enter the trials will be eligible for the finals. In the event not more than 12 horses are eligible to enter the trials, there may be no trials and a 12-horse gate may be used for the finals with the 11th and 12th place horses receiving no money.
11. **RACE DATES:** OQHRA reserves the right to reschedule, postpone, revise the conditions for, or cancel the races for any reason which it deems sufficient. Any nomination to the races may be refused without liability by OQHRA for any reason at any time prior to the actual running of the final races. If the races are canceled, all nominating and sustaining payments theretofore paid, less the amounts deducted for advertising and administrative expenses will be refunded.
12. **CHANGE OF ADDRESS:** The owner of a horse nominated to the race is responsible for notifying race sponsor of the sale of a horse nominated to the race or of a change in the owner's address.
13. **SPONSOR:** This race is sponsored by OQHRA. All disputes as to eligibility to participate in the race will be determined in the sole discretion of OQHRA and the decision of OQHRA will be absolute, final and binding.
14. **RACING RULES:** The race dates, conditions, and added money are subject to approval by OQHRA, Will Rogers Downs, and the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. The decision of the stewards or the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission in all matters under their jurisdiction will be final. Nominations are accepted only on the condition that those persons nominating or starting a horse in the trials or the finals agree to abide by these race conditions; the rules and regulations promulgated by Will Rogers Downs, the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission Rules Of Racing (Pari-mutuel), and all other rules, regulations and conditions promulgated by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission or any other applicable governmental authority or the race sponsor.
15. **OTHER CONDITIONS:** Eligibility for a stakes race does not guarantee a stall assignment for the entire meet. No entry will be received and no stabling will be permitted except upon the conditions that all disputes, claims, and objections arising out of racing or with respect to interpretations of any rules, conditions of races, or otherwise shall be decided by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, the stewards, the racetrack management, or the race sponsor and such decision upon all points shall be final. All horses, either by the time or performances, which do not meet OHRC or racetrack eligibility rules, will be ineligible.
