A positive report for any prohibited substance will result in loss of eligibility to participate in trials or final as determined by OHRC Stewards. If pre-race examination or substance testing prior to or following a race is refused by owner or trainer of eligible horse and results in the horse being ineligible to participate, there will be no refund of payments. It is the responsibility of the owner and/or trainer to make sure their entry is duly registered and eligible by meeting all conditions as published. Should a horse be ineligible and scratched, all fees paid in will be forfeited to the purse and not subject to refund. By making entry into this race, I agree to abide by the rules and regulations as published by the Race Administrator, OHRC, Host Racetrack and enforced by the OHRC Stewards and to accept their decision as final.

2027 REMINGTON PARK OKLAHOMA BRED FUTURITY RACE CONDITIONS:

By signing the front page of the nomination form, the signee has read this document and represents and warrants that (i) he/she is the owner of all interests in the nominated horse or has full authority on behalf of the owner or owners of the nominated horse to execute this nomination and bind all persons with a legal interest in the nominated horse to the conditions, requirements, restrictions and waivers set forth on this nomination form and race conditions, and (ii) these conditions shall be binding on any future owner of any interest in the nominated horse.

The nominator, owner and owner's agents and representative understand that Race Administrator, Host Racetrack or the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission may implement safety or animal welfare protocols or controls over pre-race activities, testing, surveillance, and on-grounds activities ("Protocols") and agree to be bound by such Protocols. If Race Administrator deems it necessary for additional assistance in maintaining the integrity of this race all expenses for such assistance may be deducted from the gross purse.

Any prohibited medication positives will result in loss of eligibility to participate in trials or final as determined by Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission (OHRC) or OHRC Stewards. If pre-race examination or substance testing prior to or following a race is refused by owner or trainer of eligible horse and results in the horse being ineligible to participate, there will be no refund of payments. Eligible participants will be required to comply with all hair testing requirements included in these conditions.

- 1. ELIGIBLE HORSES:** Only **Accredited Oklahoma-Bred** Quarter Horse foals of 2025 who are registered with American Quarter Horse Association, and which are owned or nominated by owners who agree to the conditions of this race(s) as follows, are eligible to enter the race. An owner may nominate as many horses as desired. *A COPY OF THE REGISTRATION PAPERS WITH THE OKB ACCREDITED STAMP MUST BE PROVIDED prior to February 15.* No refunds will be made for nomination and sustaining payments paid for a horse that is ineligible to be accredited or which is eligible but has not been properly accredited prior to running of the trials except that any horse that is determined ineligible for accreditation will receive a refund of the original nomination fee if Race Administrator is notified prior to the due date for the next payment deadline after the horse was nominated and determined ineligible to be accredited as an Oklahoma Bred racehorse. If one or more nominations are withdrawn prior to the running of the trials, it is the owner's responsibility to specify which horses are being withdrawn and which horses are to remain eligible when making payments.
- 2. PAYMENTS:** Except as provided herein, the failure to make all payments on or before the designated dates will result in a termination of the nomination and all prior nominating and sustaining payments will be forfeited. All payments must be postmarked no later than the due date and should be sent by registered or certified mail. The sender's receipt must be date stamped by the United States Postal Service and presented as proof of mailing if date discrepancies occur. Postage metered dates will not be accepted if payments are not received by the due date. United States Postal Service date stamped metered mail will constitute evidence of mailing if dated, mailed, and stamped on or before due date. Any returned check(s) constitutes no payment. In the event a sustaining payment is late (the "Late Payment"), a nomination of the eligible horse will not be terminated if, on or before the due date of the next immediate sustaining payment (or the entry date if the late payment is the last sustaining payment), the person nominating the eligible horse pays (a) such next sustaining payment; (b) the late payment; and (c) an additional amount equal to the late payment. The foregoing provision will not apply to consecutive sustaining payments. Credit card payments will be subject to a 3.5% convenience fee.
- 3. SUPPLEMENTARY NOMINATIONS:** Late supplemental entry for eligible horses will be permitted prior to trial entry on payment of \$25,000.00 by cashier's check or other immediately available funds on deposit with the Horsemen's bookkeeper at time of entry.
- 4. ADDED MONEY AND PURSE DISTRIBUTION:** The Net Purse for the 2027 Futurity will include all nomination fees, sustaining fees, late fees, and supplemental nomination fees less 10% of the foregoing for advertising, accounting, and administrative expenses plus \$200,000 added from Horsemen's Purse Funds and plus \$70,000 added to purse from Oklahoma Breeding Development Fund for Quarter Horses and an additional \$5,000 per trial from Oklahoma Breeding Development Funds that will be included in the total purse for each trial race. Futurity Trial Purses will total \$15,000 per race which includes \$10,000 from the Horsemen's Purse Funds and \$5,000 from the Oklahoma Breeding Development Funds. 2027 Juvenile Purse of \$100,000 will be paid from Horsemen's Purse Funds. Trial purse money paid by Host Racetrack will be distributed in the same manner as overnight races during the meet. The additional \$5,000 of Oklahoma Bred Funds for each trial will pay five places (60%, 20%, 11%, 6%, and 3%). The remainder of the Oklahoma Bred Funds for the Futurity final will pay places using the same purse distribution formula as used by the track for the Futurity final and the Juvenile. All Oklahoma Breeding Development Funds for trials and final will be distributed by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. Interest earned, if any, on escrowed purse funds after payment of any bank service fee will go to the race administrator. Remaining balance of Net Purse will be distributed by the Horsemen's Bookkeeper at Host Racetrack. Futurity final and Juvenile purse money distributed by track and the OHRC will pay 10 places using the following formula: 40%, 17%, 11%, 9%, 7%, 5%, 4%, 3%, 2%, 2%.
- 5. SUBSTANCE TESTING:** As a condition for participation in this race, all horses nominated to OQHRA administered futurities or derbies (the "Races") will be subject to substance testing by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. Every entry for the trials associated with the Races must have a negative hair test for prohibited substances in accordance with the same pre-entry hair test requirements implemented by Host Racetrack. Additionally, the top 30 qualifiers for this race, based on trial times, will be required to provide a negative hair test for prohibited substances, after the trials and before entry date for the final for such Races, in accordance with the same pre-entry hair test requirements implemented by Host Racetrack. A positive report for any prohibited substance or *failure to present a horse(s) for testing at the published date and time* will result in loss of eligibility to participate in trials or final of such Races. If a horse is declared ineligible for any reason, before entries close for the final or juvenile, the next fastest horse from the same day of trials as the ineligible horse will be moved up. If a qualifier to the final dies or becomes injured (and otherwise eligible to enter the final) that horse will receive last place money (this does not apply to a juvenile). Injured qualifiers must present for testing unless they have received a written waiver from the OHRC Stewards. Test results will be reported to the host track officials and notification of positives will be sent to the trainer of the nominated horse.

By submitting a signed nomination form for this race, by or on behalf of the owner of the nominated horse, the owner's agents and representatives, and the owner's heirs and assigns (including any future owner of the nominated horse) agrees to be subject to and abide by the results of the initial (commonly referred to as the "sample A test") hair testing of the nominated horse and voluntarily and irrevocably waives the following:

- a. Any and all rights to have a secondary or split sample tested,
- b. Any and all rights to a hearing (whether formal, informal, by written submission or in person) to contest the results of the initial test or the resulting denial of entry in the race, whether a trial race or final race,
- c. Any and all rights to contest, under any circumstances or grounds, the results of the initial test or the resulting denial of entry in the race, whether a trial race or final race,
- d. Any and all rights to challenge the results of the initial test or resulting denial of entry in the race, whether a trial race or final race, directly or indirectly, before any court or other tribunal; and
- e. By their entry into the race, all participants irrevocably waive any legal claim they might have against Race Administrator and/or Host Racetrack, its officers, executive committee members, or its employees arising from or related to the hair testing which is the subject of this paragraph.

A report of the result of an unofficial test submitted as a requirement of eligibility for entry is not admissible for any purpose in any OHRC proceeding arising from a positive report of an official test administered by OHRC.

Should any owner of a nominated horse, the owner's agents and/or representatives, and the owner's heirs and/or assigns file any action in a court of law or other tribunal contesting the Race Administrator and/or Racetrack's decision to exclude a horse from the race despite their express waiver of the right to pursue such action, and the owner fails to obtain a final, appealable order in his or her favor, the owner shall pay the reasonable attorney fees of the Race Administrator and/or Racetrack incurred in defending any such action.

6. ENHANCED INTEGRITY AND ANIMAL WELFARE PROTOCOLS: In addition to the requirements set forth in Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission rules and these Race Conditions, any horse nominated to this race shall be subject to the following enhanced integrity protocols from nomination through completion of the final.

- a. **Out-of-Competition Testing.** Blood, urine, hair, saliva, or any other biological sample may be collected at any time from nomination through completion of the final. Refusal to submit the requested sample shall result in immediate loss of eligibility and forfeiture of all nomination, sustaining, entry, and related fees.
- b. **Secured Detention or Observation Barn.** Qualifiers may be required to be housed in a secured detention barn, observation barn, or similar facility designated by the Race Administrator or the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. Security measures may include surveillance cameras, controlled access points, visitor logs, security personnel, stall monitoring, chain of custody procedures, and other integrity oversight measures deemed necessary to protect the integrity of the race. Participation in such security protocols shall be a condition of eligibility for the final.
- c. **Biological Monitoring.** The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission and/or the Race Administrator may establish baseline biological profiles or biological passports for nominated horses. Material deviations from a horse's established biological profile, as determined by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, may result in additional testing, veterinary examination, surveillance, or investigation, temporary ineligibility, disqualification, or any other condition established by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission or Board of Stewards.
- d. **Advanced Scientific Testing.** Horses may be subject to gene-doping screening, blood manipulation screening, erythropoiesis stimulating agent (ESA) testing, erythropoietin (EPO) testing, and any other scientifically accepted testing methodology available at the time of testing.
- e. **Post-Trial Veterinary Monitoring.** Qualifiers may be required to undergo blood testing, including but not limited to complete blood count (CBC), chemistry panel, muscle enzyme analysis, cardiac biomarker testing, endocrine testing, thyroid testing, electrocardiogram (ECG), Kardia monitoring, echocardiography, or other diagnostic testing deemed necessary by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. Horses exhibiting abnormal findings may be subject to additional testing, veterinary review, temporary ineligibility, or other conditions established by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission or Board of Stewards.
- f. **Positive Findings.** Any positive finding for a prohibited substance by any racing jurisdiction beginning at the time of original nomination payment through the running of the race may result in loss of eligibility, disqualification, forfeiture of purse monies, forfeiture of nomination and sustaining payments, forfeiture of awards, and any additional sanctions authorized by Oklahoma Law.
- g. **Return of Awards.** As a condition of nomination, owners agree to return any trophy, buckle, blanket, or purse monies awarded in connection with the race, or reimburse the race administrator for the reasonable replacement cost thereof, in the event of a subsequent disqualification.

7. SUSPENDED OR INELIGIBLE PERSONS: No person who is suspended, excluded, denied privileges, or otherwise declared ineligible by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission or any recognized racing jurisdiction may nominate a horse, make a sustaining payment, enter a horse, or otherwise act on behalf of a horse in connection with this race while such suspension, exclusion, denial of privileges, or ineligibility is in effect.

Any nomination, sustaining payment, or entry submitted by or through a suspended, excluded, denied, or ineligible person while such status is in effect shall be rejected and the horse shall be ineligible unless and until all race conditions have been satisfied by an eligible person within the applicable deadlines.

For purposes of this provision, eligibility shall be determined on the date the nomination, sustaining payment, or entry is submitted.

8. ENTRY: Entries in all races must be made through the entry box at Host Racetrack Racing Office by closing time for entries in that race. Nominations to the race do not guarantee the availability of stalls at Host Racetrack for nominated horses.

9. TIME TRIALS: Host Racetrack and Race Administrator will determine if there are enough entries to conduct one or two days of trials based on possible number of entries for the trials. Horses shall qualify based on time and order of finish. Times will be determined only to the limit of the timer, the only exception is when two or more horses have the same exact time in the same trial heat. Then the order of finish shall also determine the preference in qualifying for the final. Except in the case of a disqualification, under no circumstances shall a horse qualify ahead of a horse that finished ahead of that horse in the official order of finish. Should a horse be disqualified for interference during the running of a time trial, it shall receive the time of the horse it is immediately placed behind plus one hundredth (1/100) of a second, or to the maximum accuracy of the electronic timing device. No adjustments shall be made in the times recorded in the time trials to account for head wind, tail wind, off track, etc. In the event of a timer malfunction of a trial race, the OHRC stewards will use the technological aide of video frame by frame analysis to assign times to each participating horse in that trial. Every qualifier eligible to enter the final will be required to remain on the grounds and stabled in the barn area of the racetrack after the trials and until the running of the final.

- **TIES IN TIME TRIALS:** If only one day of trials is conducted and a tie for the 10th fastest time occurs, 11 horses will be allowed to run in the final and the purse will be adjusted accordingly. No more than 11 horses will be allowed to run in the final if trials are conducted. If more than two horses are tied for 10th place, the final two positions will be determined by lot. If two days of trials are conducted the five fastest qualifiers from each day will advance to the final. If a tie occurs for the 5th fastest time at the end of trials for that day, the final position will be determined by lot between all horses with that time. If a horse is withdrawn, scratched, or deemed ineligible for any reason after the time trials and before entry for the final (or juvenile, if applicable) only a horse that ran in the time trials on the same day is eligible to move into that specific horse's position. A horse from the other day of time trials (if there were two days) is not eligible to move into that position.
10. **FINAL:** The finalists for the Futurity will be determined by taking the ten (10) fastest times from all the trials. The final will consist of a field of no more than ten (10) horses unless otherwise determined within these conditions. In addition to the pre-entry hair testing, **only the fastest 30 qualifiers for the 2027 Futurity based on trial times will be eligible and required to comply with collection of another hair sample which will be collected and tested after the trials and prior to entry for the final. This sample will be collected at a time and location approved by the race administrator in conjunction with the OQHRA who facilitates the collection of hair samples. Any horse failing to produce a clean hair test free of prohibited substances will not be eligible to enter the final or the Juvenile regardless of the qualifying time.** In the event ten (10) or fewer horses are eligible prior to the trials, participation in the trials will not be required to qualify for the final. Race Administrator may determine that in the event not more than 12 horses are eligible to enter trials, there may be no trials and a 12-horse gate may be used for the final with the 11th and 12th place horses receiving no money. Horses running in trials with 11-30th fastest times (or 6-15 each day) to the Futurity Final will be eligible for entry in the Juvenile with preference for fastest non-qualifying times. None of the 11-30 fastest horses failing to provide a clean hair test from the post-trial testing will be eligible to enter the Juvenile. No purse money will be paid to Juvenile entries that are scratched for any reason prior to running of the Juvenile. Any remaining purse money with respect to such withdrawn horses will be distributed proportionately to those horses running in the Juvenile in accordance with purse distribution percentages. If a horse is withdrawn, scratched, or deemed ineligible for any reason after the time trials and before the final only a horse that ran in the time trials on the same day is eligible to move into that horse's position. A horse from the other day of time trials is not eligible to move into a position earned during the other day of time trials.
 11. **SCRATCHES:** If a horse is ruled ineligible by the OHRC stewards or the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission for entry into either the trials or the final or if the OHRC stewards scratch or disqualify a horse from either the trials or the final described herein for a rule violation, such horse may be ineligible for receipt of any purse money. After the entry date for the final, the purse money that might have been due to such horse will be divided proportionately (based on purse percentages) among the other starters in such race. If, after the entry date for such race, one or more horses are withdrawn from the final for any reason other than ineligibility or a rule violation, the purse monies (in inverse order of finish) equal to the number of withdrawn horses for such race will be distributed equally to the owners of the horses withdrawn from such final. If, prior to the entry date for the final a horse is ruled ineligible for the final as provided above, the next eligible horse may be entered in such race.
 12. **RACE DATES:** Race Administrator reserves the right to amend these terms of participation and competition at its discretion and at any time with the parameters of the rules and regulations of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission.

Participation in this race is a privilege and not a right. The Race Administrator may refuse, suspend, or revoke the eligibility of any horse when necessary to protect the integrity, safety, welfare, reputation, or orderly administration of the race.

Any horse determined to be ineligible as a result of a positive test, refusal to submit to testing, failure to comply with security or integrity protocols, submission of false or misleading information, participation by a suspended or ineligible person, or other violation of these Race Conditions shall forfeit all nomination, sustaining, entry, and related fees unless otherwise determined by the Race Administrator.
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 14. **CHANGE OF ADDRESS:** The owner of a horse nominated to the race is responsible for notifying Race Administrator of the sale of a horse nominated to the race or of a change in the owner's address.
 15. **ADMINISTRATOR:** The race is administered and sponsored by OQHRA. All disputes as to the eligibility to participate in the race will be determined in the sole discretion of OQHRA and the decision of OQHRA will be absolute, final and binding.
 16. **RACING RULES:** The race dates and the race conditions are subject to approval by Race Administrator, Host Racetrack, and the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. The decision of the OHRC stewards or the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission in all matters under their authority will be final. Nominations are accepted only on the condition that those persons nominating or starting a horse in the trials and the final agree to abide by these race conditions, the rules and regulations promulgated by Host Racetrack, the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission Rules of Racing (Pari-mutuel), and all other rules, regulations and conditions promulgated by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission or any other applicable governmental authority or the race administrator.
